Approved minutes from May Meeting as amended

- 1) Volleyball Board – Season wrap up. Cameras have been purchased with funds donated by Conover family. Tripods will be purchased in July, Some assignor issues, working on philosophy. Scorers/Timers need to fill out application if they wish to do lines. Discussed pay scale for UNLV games. Volleyball fees will not change next year. Playoffs went well. Discussed year end split.
- 2) Memberships – If BofC decides not to accept members application, NIAA will not hear appeal. They will hear appeal for member suspended during the year.
- 3) Virgin Valley Soccer Tournament – If games times are reduced by 30 minutes will accept reduced game fees
- 4) NIAA Meeting – Next season game fees will remain the same as last year. Travel to North for State playoffs will remain basically the same next year as it was this year. Future – 3A schools move to 4A, will have A & B Divisions based on performance in all sports. Golf and tennis may become 'pay to play' sports. All Federation tests will be done on-line. No reduction of games next season.
