Meeting called to order at 4:33pm.

A motion was made and passed by vote to approve the Previous meeting's minutes.

A member of the Basketball Board appeared to discuss an issue with a current member possibly in direct competition with SNOA. It was decided that the Basketball Board would vote on what action to take.

The Sullenburger Classic will be held in Las Vegas. SNOA will host a dinner for all officials and a few guests involved in the game. A motion was made for the BoC to fund this dinner. The motion was approved by vote.

It was discussed that Kelley McGee has been appointed as the new Volleyball Assignor. Greg Simintal and Tom Mahoney were appointed as the new instructors for Softball.

It was discussed that there is a supplemental insurance policy available that would cover lost games fees due to injury. It is \$10 per official, per year. It was decided to solicit the opinion of the membership through a survey.

It was noted that the Basketball and Football camps were huge successes. A motion was made to give gift cards to those that help run the camps. The motion was passed by vote.

The possibility of adding ArbiterConnect was discussed. A motion was made to table the matter until next year.

Vince provided a summary of the NIAA meeting. A final decision has not been made yet, but background checks will likely be put in place beginning next school

year. Baseball/Softball will add “15 after 3” to the run rule. Volleyball officials will be allowed to attend 5 total meeting during the school year to cover for both the Boys and the Girls seasons.

The proposed budget was reviewed. A motion was made to approve the budget. The motion passed by vote.

A motion was made to donate \$200 to the Baseball Charity Golf Tournament. The motion was passed by vote.
